Minister's Message

Hello friends, and Happy New Year!

As you begin to read this message, I'm going to ask you to do something: Take a moment and check out where you are inside of yourself. Are you feeling great, feeling like 2007 is going to be a fabulous year, one filled with "points of Light"? Are you feeling at least optimistic and hopeful about this coming year? Or, on the other hand, do you feel it is not going to be much different than the year that just ended, or maybe even that things will probably get worse before they get better? Are you feeling optimistic or pessimistic about this brand new year of 2007? You know there will never be another year quite like this one that is beginning.

The wonderful thing about a new beginning is we get to choose what we will create in this New Year. NEWS from the Board of Trustees by Dr. Bonnie Jean Young

Finances. Several urgent matters have caused the Board to approve some expenditures the past two months. The first was the discovery that we couldn't repair the keyboard piano anymore. They just don't make parts for it because of its age. Rev. Richardson was able to find a company that would take a trade-in and had an **electronic keyboard** that was within our budget. Music Director, Rebecca Sheppard, liked the keyboard piano so the Board purchased it.

The next item that needed replacing was the Youth Ed **TV/Video/DVD player**. Steve Sheppard was able to find one at Best Buy that was on sale for 20% off, so the Board authorized the purchase. It is a 27 Inch Sylvania that will accept a digital camera card. We feel that it will have a lot of applications.

Of course, everyone is aware of the rain leaks on the sun porch that needed fixing. Jim Wallace worked with the Roof Doctor to place a sleeve around the chimney and to replace some shingles that allowed the rain to seep in. The bill for the **roof repair** is about \$1600.

Rev. Georgie Richardson and Diana Moskal have been using Georgie's private Mac computer to do Church work for 11 years. The **computer and the printer** finally gave out. The Board felt that the church should supply the computer and printer for the Minister and the Associate. We were able to purchase an iMac computer on sale at the Computer Store and an HP Photo Smart printer for \$40 off at Costco. Board members also recommended that the church purchase a DSL line for Internet research and communication. Betty Sword, Office Manager, has become so competent running the programs on the Gateway type computer that she spends a lot of her time keeping budget figures and records on the computer.

The Fire Marshall paid us a visit. Her inspection revealed some deficiencies that cost a few dollars. You may have noticed that we now have **two "lighted" Exit signs** above the main door in the Sanctuary. We also had to replace the **heater** in Georgie's office with one that turned off if the heater was tipped over.

The work that the Grounds staff and volunteers on drains on the South side of the Sanctuary seems to be accomplishing its purpose--to keep the basement dry.

Fun Activities Top off the Fall. The Board wound up the summer by providing another fun **potluck and sing-a-long** by John and Blythe. A group of about 35 came to honor the Unity volunteers. We followed the Potluck with a **Harvest Time Barn Dance** at the end of October. The Board decided that this was so much fun we want to make it an annual event, but maybe hold it earlier in September. The weather might be warmer. *President's Message Continues....*

Manifesting the Dream

Reverend Georgie has brought together a group of dedicated individuals to serve as the Core Team for the manifestation of our vision for a new sanctuary. The members of the Core Team are Reverend Georgie, Diana Moskal, Jim Harris, Don & Ellen McCaig, Alice Sawyer, Reiny Leskey, Dick Thomas, Kara Driskell, June Hadlock, Michael Sutton, and Bonnie Jean Young. To date the team has had two meetings. The first was to get acquainted and to get a general idea of what we would like to see in a new sanctuary and to affirm all of the reasons we will successfully manifest our vision. The second meeting was to establish our rules for conducting our meeting and to begin to outline the process we will be using to gather information for the start up phase of the project.

We have dedicated ourselves to being the voice of our spiritual community and to actively seeking input from the community before we make any recommendations to the Board for action. We are also dedicated to keeping the community actively involved and thoroughly informed at all stages of the process.

To gather needed information from the community so that we can begin the development process we will be distributing a survey on each of the first three Sundays in January. The survey will be asking you to provide your thoughts on how big you think the sanctuary should be, where on the property you think it should be located, and what uses, besides the auditorium, should be included in the new building. We will be asking you to complete your survey before you leave after service so that we make sure everyone gets his or her opinions heard. We will have a short meeting after service on the fourth Sunday of January to summarize the results of the survey, to answer any questions you may have about the process and to get any last minute input from the community.

We welcome your input and are available to answer any questions you may have at anytime. Feel free contact to any one of the team members before or after service.

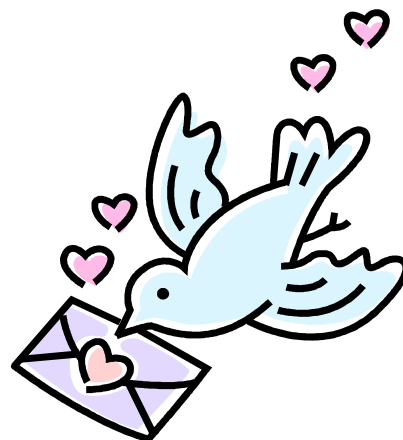
Ho'oponopono Workshop:

Kara Driskell will be offering a workshop on the healing method called Ho'oponopono. This material comes to us from Dr. Len out of Hawaii who healed many of the people locked up and labeled criminally insane. Kara received the training in Bend, OR and again in Vancouver, BC from Dr. Len. She will be bringing the essence of this important work to us on Sunday afternoon, January 21st from 1:00-3:00 on love offering basis.

The entire love offering will be placed in the Nettie Eberhart scholarship fund to assist others who may desire to attend a seminar or receive specific training. (Read more about the scholarship fund below).

Nettie Eberhart Scholarship:

The scholarship fund was created in appreciation to Nettie Eberhart who bequeathed her estate to Unity of Salem a few years ago. The scholarship is for \$500.00 and is offered twice a year in March and September. In order to receive the scholarship, you must be an active member of Unity of Salem, and have a desire to attend a workshop, training, class or seminar away from Unity of Salem. If you wish to attend something in April, May or June, for instance, you would need to apply by the March 1st deadline. If you receive the monies, after you attend the training, etc, you will be required to set a date to offer what you have learned to the congregation through a workshop or lecture basis. This is given on a love-offering basis and the entire love offering is then placed back into the fund so it is nearly self-perpetuating. If you are interested in applying for a scholarship, there are forms on the kitchen counter for further information and direction.

Board Committees Are Busy and Productive. The **By-Laws Revision Committee**, chaired by Ed Lent, has finished its revisions and will make recommendations to the Board of Trustees at their January meeting. The proposed revisions will be presented in May 2007 at the Annual Meeting.

The **Energizing Nine Acres Committee**, co-chaired by Vice President Reiny Leske and Board member Dick Thomas, has focused its energies on the plantings in the Berms of the new parking lot, plans for a labyrinth, and the spreading of the bark chips donated by tree trimming companies for our new Christmas tree plot near the Exit road. The newest board committee, The **Unity Core Sanctuary Committee**, chaired by Jim Harris, has had three meetings and is emerging as a committee dedicated to openness and communication. The group has designed a survey that will be available the first three Sundays in January for folks to fill out. The committee is seeking information about the size of congregation we should plan for and where you think the Sanctuary should be sited. The astounding piece of information that was revealed in the first committee meeting was that Jim Harris has an architectural degree from the University of Oregon and dreamed many years ago that he would design a church and shepherd it to reality.

The Unity of Salem Board of Trustees is grateful for the many opportunities that **Unity Friends** provides for us to share our abundance with others in our community. Whether we are giving food to the Marion and Polk Food Share, providing loved Teddy Bears and other cuddly

critters for Homeless children, or presents for the Christmas tree, the Unity Friends Team, led by Diane Van Gorder, is there to assist.

During the year we have recognized the many volunteers who serve Unity of Salem. In December we took time to recognize another group. Twenty five members of **Readers Theatre** have produced 31 performances during Sunday Services, at Hallman Elementary School on Dr. Seuss Day, and at Memorial Services during the last two and a half years.
