## What's In A Birthday?

I celebrated a birthday in April. It was one of those mile-stone birthdays. I turned 70 years old on Wednesday, April 9<sup>th</sup>. There are some people (and a number of ministers) who do not desire to share their age. In fact, for many it is a national secret. I've never felt that way. I'm not exactly sure why. Perhaps it is because I feel I've "earned" every one of my years.

I was particularly excited to turn 70. As the BIG day approached, I found myself looking forward to it with great anticipation. Several people asked me why I was so excited to turn 70, and finally I asked myself, why the excitement, after all it is just another year. The answer I received from "myself" is that I feel at age 70 the Sage begins to appear. Now that may or may not be true, but it feels true for me.

Shirley MacLaine recently wrote a book entitled "Sage-ing While Age-Ing" As she shares her life in this book, and her process of "sage-ing", she says: "I believe the great creator intended for all of us to feel happiness. ... I try to be nonjudgmental on my road to completion, understanding, and happiness." And, she invites us to stay open-minded so that our Truth may emerge.

# A Message From The Board President

*Dr. Bonnie Jean Young:*

**Board Activities:** The Board of Trustees has been attending congregational meetings about the Sanctuary building plans, “spiffing up” the grounds and buildings, monitoring the budget and planning for the 2009 Budget, planning the Annual Meeting, meeting with staff to listen to their project plans, and planning new events and workshops.

**Finances 2007-2008:** Our budget projections for completing the 2007-2008 year look positive. Let’s continue our commitment to our “faith budget” so we will finish this year “in the black”.

**Budget for 2008-2009:** Rev. Georgie Richardson is preparing the proposed budget for next year. After approval at the April 29<sup>th</sup> Board meeting, the budget will be printed and copies will be made available in the kitchen.

**Annual Meeting, May 18<sup>th</sup>:** After church on May 18<sup>th</sup>, the Board of Trustees will hold the church Annual meeting. Rev. Richardson and I will talk to the membership about the church’s accomplishments and the plans for the future. The Treasurer, Carol Wilson, will present the proposed new budget, answer questions, and ask for approval from the members. A vote on the proposed new Board members and an alternate will be conducted and a new member will be elected to the nominating committee for 2009.

**Staff Meet with Board:** Nancie Anderson met with the Board to share her plans for repairing the barn roof and to discuss the costs. The Board asked Nancie to investigate the solutions and make the repairs. Nancie has recently returned to the position of Operations Manager after having a medical leave. The Board expresses appreciation to Dr. Jim Wallace for filling in during Nancie’s leave.

**Board Goes High Tech:** Paula Wills, Multimedia Director, met with the Board recently to discuss plans for the newsletter

and the Unity of Salem Website. She demonstrated the possibilities by showing us various websites, and pointed out the advantages and disadvantages of certain components and their costs. The Board members expressed their likes and dislikes and will revisit the plans in 6 months.

**Building Plans for the New Sanctuary:** The Board authorized the expenditure of \$19,000 from the Building Fund and from the interest from CD Rollovers to pay for the building design phase for the new Sanctuary. After the design is completed, the Board has put future developments “on hold” until the Building Fund is replenished enough for the next phase.

**The Board Leases a Color Copier:** “Ask and ye shall receive...” Just as we were ready to print this newsletter, the company from whom we leased the black and white copier dropped into the office with a picture of a refurbished color copy machine at a phenomenal savings. At an emergency meeting, the Board authorized Rev. Georgie to make the deal. The newsletter you are reading this month was printed on our own leased machine!

**Architect Presents Sanctuary Sketches:** Those who stayed after the Sunday Service on April 13<sup>th</sup>, were treated to various visual sketches of our proposed sanctuary. What a thrill to see the possibilities projected on our media screen! More handicapped parking, closer to the building, were just a small part of the changes in response to our last meeting with the Core Team. For the first time we saw the side views and the inside views of the buildings, making our dream one step closer to reality. We were able to see how the natural light looked at various times of the day. When the final design is selected, Nathan will provide a picture for our web site, with a virtual tour of the building.
