Hello friends,

I am writing you fresh from spending a week at the 2009 Unity People's conference that was held in Overland Park, Kansas. The theme of this year's conference was *Spirit Rising: Time to fly. Time to thrive.*

The big news to share with you is that Unity of Salem was honored along with 29 other ministries for completing the Thriving Unity program that we have been participating in this past year. Completing this program was a prerequisite to applying for the pilot program the Association of Unity is offering entitled *Transformational Experience – Enlightened Leader's*

Program. As only 15 of the churches applying would be chosen, there was a lottery during the business meeting on Wednesday, June 10th. We were the eleventh church chosen to be part of the pilot program. We were also honored during a special luncheon held for us that day. Rev. James Trapp, the CEO of the Association, was in attendance making his way to every table and thanking each of us for participating in the Thriving Unity program. We were presented with a special plaque for our efforts that we will share during our Thriving Unity Celebration Sunday, July 12th. An extra special part for Unity of Salem was that all of our Benchmark Notebooks were displayed for everyone at the conference to see. We were the only church out of



the 30 churches that participated and completed the Benchmarks to present our completed material in the form of a well-documented notebook complete with many pictures.

The next step, the pilot program, will unfold during the months ahead to officially begin in October. At this point we aren't sure what all this entails for us, however, it will be very important that a large percentage of our congregation be enthusiastically engaged if we are to go forward. We will keep you informed as soon as we know more.

The overall theme of the conference was very uplifting. We heard from many brilliant presenters, including Lynn Twist who wrote the book *Soul of Money*. She is (Continued on Page 4)

CHAPLAIN TEAM

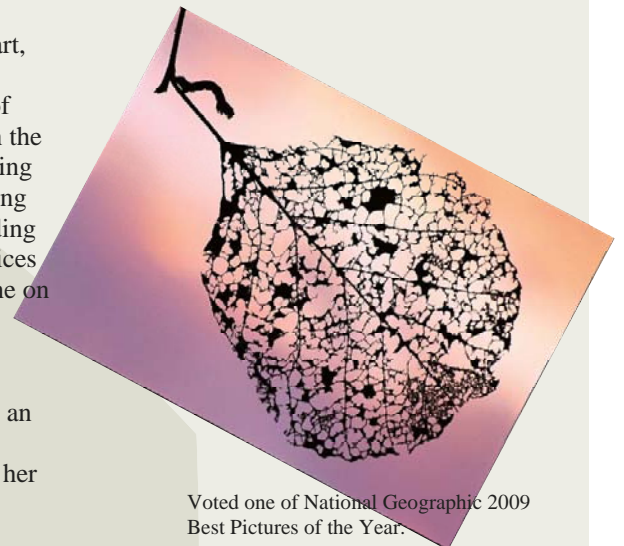

also the driving force behind a program that she is co-sponsoring with the Indigenous Tribes of the Amazon entitled "Awakening the Dreamer". It is their belief that most of the world is "asleep" as to how we are treating one another and our planet. There was no blaming; just pointing out how critical it is that we all wake up from the current dream of consumption that we are dreaming. Lynn closed with a wonderful analogy, and I leave you with this thought:

There is a caterpillar that will, at a certain time, consume one hundred times its weight in a day. It will eat an entire tree. When it goes into the cocoon there are imaginal cells that begin to seek each other even though the other cells try to fight them. One by one the imaginal cells find each other and begin to join together, gradually the rest of the cells become the nutrients in the process. We know the end result is the butterfly. **My friends, you and I are the imaginal cells, finding each other, coming together with a consciousness of love, appreciation, respect and honor for our planet and for one another. Let's keep up the good work! There truly are a lot of us!**

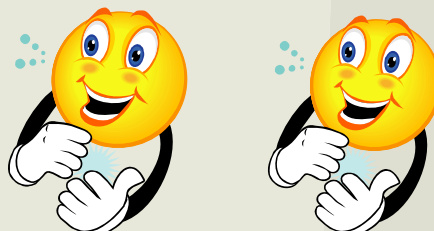
