A Message From The Board President

Dr. Bonnie Jean Young:

The last two months have been spent in developing policies, monitoring the financial status of Unity of Salem, winding down the committee business of the current board, interviewing candidates for the Board positions, working with teams to assist them in taking ownership of their work, and completing all the Benchmark Requirements for the Thriving in Unity Program and applying for the Pilot Program.

Policies and Communication: The Board of Trustees finished the drafts of the Shared Membership Agreement and the Policy on Conflict Resolution. These documents were available for two weeks prior to the Community Sharing held on April 14th. The documents were discussed. Comments were positive about both papers. They will be presented at the Annual Meeting.

Financial Status: Our financial statement indicates that we are \$2,736 below our projected income for this time of year and \$9,041 below our projected expenses. This deferral of maintenance will catch up to us eventually, and we may have to ask for a special offering if we have a major repair need. The Board is now looking at a proposed budget calling for an \$18,000 faith budget (\$4,000 more than last year) to cover projected needs.

Committee Reports: The Nominating Committee has prepared a slate of nominees for three Board positions and one alternate position. The CORE Team report indicated that the planning activities of the Backyard Wildlife Habitat Team have begun. The Pea Patch Community Garden has been built at the east end of the Modular. Planting began on April 17th while a deer fence was being built.

Visioning with Teams and Studying Styles: Rev. Georgie Richardson is leading

many teams in their visioning process. They are also preparing to take the Communication Styles Workshop offered by Dr. Bonnie Staebler. Some teams are requesting that Dr. Staebler meet with their team individually to analyze how their styles may affect the functioning of their team.

Representatives to Attend Conferences: Rev. Georgie Richardson, Diana Moskal and Ann Armstrong will attend the NW Regional Conference. Georgie and Diana will also attend the People's Conference in June and will be accompanied by Dr. Bonnie Staebler and Diane Van Gorder.

Thriving in Unity Progress: Unity of Salem has completed all the Ministry Requirements of the Twelve Benchmarks. The Minister and the four Board officers have been interviewed by Review Board members of the Transformation Experience for our selection as a Pilot Program Church. Please continue to hold Unity of Salem in your prayers. We will know at the People's Conference in June if we are selected. Thanks to all of you who have participated.

Good-Byes Are Difficult: May is the last meeting of your present Board of Trustees. Four of us will be saying goodbye to our work on the Board, and you will be electing four new members to serve. We appreciate the opportunity to serve you, the members, in this way the past four years. It will be an exciting growing experience for those that you elect. We wish them continued blessings and we will turn our energies to other needs of Unity of Salem. We wish you all the best of everything that a spiritual journey at Unity of Salem can bring. 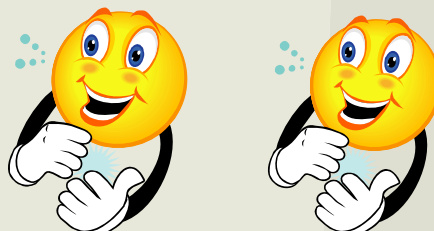

YOUTH NEWS AND ACTIVITIES

PARTNER WITH A TEEN

The Unity of Salem Youth Education Department has a new opportunity for the congregation, its "Partner with a Teen" program. This program's intention is to make it possible for the Y.O.U. (high school age) and Uniteens (middle schoolers) to attend regional retreats AND to provide intergenerational connection within our spiritual community. The teens put on a number of fundraisers during the year. This raises about half the money needed for the eligible students to attend. Two events are scheduled for this summer. The events average \$200 per person attending. We have several YOUers and a large number of Uniteens eligible to attend. You could participate in this program by writing an extra check for \$100, marking it "Partner with a Teen" and putting it in the Sunday offering. We so appreciate several of the congregation who did just that the very first Sunday it was mentioned. There will be an opportunity for each teen to connect with his/her Partner to share about their experience.

EASTER IN THE CHILDREN'S UNIVERSE

For our younger children the traditional Easter symbols of the Cross, the Crucifixion and the Resurrection are difficult and disturbing concepts to understand. Therefore, we focused this year on Easter as a symbol of New Life, Change, and Growth, as exemplified by the Butterfly. We read about, drew, "became" butterflies, as well as shared how we all grow and experience change during the years. We explained the Resurrection, when asked, as Jesus' great demonstration that there is no death and that life is eternal. 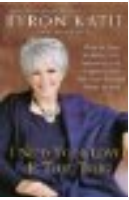
