EVOLUTION OF A SPIRITUAL COMMUNITY

Have you ever purchased a special suit or outfit for a very special event (like a wedding, graduation, special party) and because it was so special and you loved it so much, you kept it in your closet for.... 5 years, 10, years, 15 years? Then one day you decided to try it on and wear it again. Somehow it just didn't work, did it? Maybe you had gained or lost weight, maybe the style had changed, maybe you had changed and it didn't "fit" who you are now even though it definitely was "you" all those years ago.

Well, the same thing happens in a Spiritual Community. Fifteen years ago we brought to Unity of Salem Scott Peck's process called *Community Building*. It is a structured process to

bring a group through the stages of Pseudo Community (everyone is being very nice and it is all fake), to Chaos (folks are tired of the nice stuff and want to get real). If the group is mature enough it will continue through the Chaos into Emptying that is a space of letting go of prejudice, judgment, being stuck, and just totally being real. This step automatically takes the group into Genuine Community and that is a very sweet and holy place to be. If the group isn't mature enough, however, being in Chaos is frightening and the group runs back to Pseudo Community.

When we first started Community Building it fit us to a tee. It was wonderful for us to just get together and "practice" the process. Later it evolved

into what we call Community Gathering and that process is *issue driven* and is one of the tools we use for conflict resolution. Over the past 5 to 7 years we have only done Community Gathering to resolve conflict and we stopped "practicing" Community Building.

However, on the last Saturday of February we decided to take the old Community Building "outfit" out of the closet, shake off the dust, and invited folks to come together for the day just to "practice". To our delight 18 folks showed up to practice, except we found that the old favorite outfit no longer fit who we have become. We have evolved. Unity of Salem has become such an authentic, accepting and open Spiritual Community that, as we began to share, we immediately stepped into the

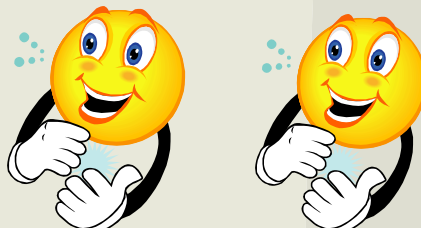

Jaine's "Lessons in the Great Plains"

Mid December through February proved to be rather tough and I've wondered what to write home about. A book came into my hands, "Finding Yourself in Transition", by Robert Brumet. I want to share a piece with you for these words helped me understand "Process" and thus, are words worth sharing. During the stages of transition, one reaches "the Void". Brumet describes it as thus: "The Void is empty, flat, and void of anything that seems solid or definite.

If an Ending could be likened to an earthquake, then the Void could be likened to being lost in the desert or adrift on an endless sea. In the Void, time and space seem to lose their former reality: self seems like a phantom – a ghost from a former incarnation; life feels flat and empty, nothing seems quite real. Every attempt to "snap out of it" or to "pull oneself together" ultimately proves futile; it is like trying to put "Humpty Dumpty" back together again".....In the Void without the familiar forms and structures, our life may feel barren and empty. Yet this can be a wonderful opportunity to view our life and our self from a new perspective. In times of barrenness, we may be able to see that which was previously hidden from our view." (Pgs. 84-86)

The Void made Jaine a VERY quiet girl; suddenly, meditation came easily and naturally. I crawled blindly to

complete and TOTAL surrender. I learned a clear distinction between faith and surrender that before had been blurred; "I have faith, why aren't I getting this?" The answer came in the void – "surrender".

I'm now in a beautiful home close to Unity Village, released of my grooming job, and picking up more and more hours at Silent Unity. In two weeks, my SEE courses begin and I will spend entire days at The Village; I'll be present every moment as spring unfolds - I revel in this Truth!

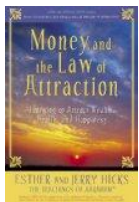

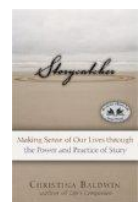

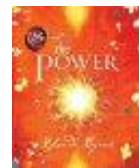
